late because I <sup>3</sup> ..... too slowly!



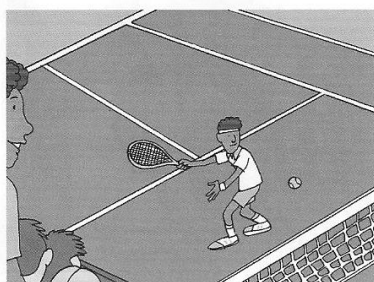
### work
